# Severe storms leave Minden residents without power

The storm that blew through Texas and Louisiana Tuesday night left fallen trees and other damage in its wake. While the Minden area fared better than the Bossier area, the effects of the storm are still visible around town. Numerous trees are down in Minden including one of the signature cypresses that once graced the entrance to St. John's Episcopal Church. Some of these trees caused damage to homes while others, fortunately, merely landed in empty areas. Many objects that easily caught the wind were destroyed. For example, the awning of the Webster Parish Tax Assessor's office was left in shambles. Parts of the city lost power and, as of Thursday morning, not all the power had yet been restored. City employees are working hard to reestablish power for the rest of the City of Minden.

# Town & Country gifts Easter baskets to CASA kids

Town & Country recently helped to spread some Easter cheer to the kids at CASA by making and delivering Easter baskets to them this past Tuesday. CASA's mission statement reads, "The mission of CASA is to speak for the best interests of abused and neglected children in the courts. We promote and support quality volunteer representation for children to provide each child a safe, permanent, nurturing home." Town & Country Health & Rehab is a healthcare facility that offers long-term and short-term care to its residents and is managed by Pathway Management. Nursing Facility Administrator Brooke Snyder, RN, spoke of Town & Country's philosophy of being

a community-first company, sharing the sentiment that, when you give to your community, your community gives back. "We're a very community-forward company, and we like to make sure that children are seen and heard and cared for. Something we hold dear to our heart is to make sure that children are cared for," said Snyder. The idea for making Easter baskets to give to CASA was spearheaded by Town & Country's Marketing/Admissions Director, Jodi Hicks. Snyder said of the initiative, "She herself is a mother, and a lot of us department heads are mothers, so we have a soft spot here for the children." A total of seventeen Easter baskets were delivered, twelve of them being donated by Town &

Country and the remaining five donated by Lifepath Hospice Care Services in Shreveport. This isn't the only initiative Town & Country participates in to reach out to local kids. They also sponsor events with the neighboring organization Mother Goose Land every month. The kids of Mother Goose Land pay that good nature forward by gifting the art they create back to the residents of the facility. Snyder stated that they even plan to create initiatives to reach out to middle school and high school aged kids in the community. Before the end of the interview, Snyder wanted to remind the readers of this publication that, for a variety of reasons, not every child will be able to take part in the joys of the Easter holiday and to

# Early childhood education becoming a focus for Webster Parish

At this month's school board meeting, three administrative job descriptions were updated due to a key supervisor's upcoming retirement. The plan is to create a new position without adding an additional employee. The job descriptions updated were for the supervisors of Elementary; Curriculum, Instruction, and Accountability; and Student Service / Child Welfare and Attendance.

Ms. Yolanda Palmer, the Federal Programs Director who oversees the federal funds, will be retiring in June after many years of service to Webster Parish. Superintendent Rowland would like to use this opportunity to redistribute her responsibilities to other positions. For example, the oversight of Title II money, which is earmarked for professional development, would become the responsibility of the Supervisor of Curriculum, Instruction, and Accountability.


One of the reasons Mr. Rowland wants to make these changes is that he would also like to create a new position without adding to the number of employees. The newest position would be for a supervisor of children ages birth to second grade. "The educational success of a child is critical based on what they get birth to three," Mr. Rowland said. "Research shows that students that have some type of affiliation or exposure to some type of early childcare center, preschool, Head

Start, definitely have an advantage over students who come to us in kindergarten with nothing. It's amazing the difference between the capabilities there." At this time, there are approximately 1,200 children in Webster Parish who have not and who probably will not receive any formal schooling before entering the public school system. While no one expects an infant to participate in formal lessons, the ability to contact new parents, teach them about activities that will aid their children's development, and make them aware of benefits and programs that are available could be a great help to these pre-students.

As part of this trend to increase and expand the parish's early childhood education, Mr. Rowland suggested that preK3 classes could be a short term goal to get the parish headed in the right direction. "With the funding that's available, we could start a preK3 program in Webster Parish soon—where we could get 3-year-olds through the Webster Parish school system." Teaching early childhood education requires an additional certification that is available in universities and which many elementary teachers already have. After some discussion, the measure to update the job descriptions passed. The new early childhood supervisor position will be considered during next month's board meeting which will be held at the Harper Pathways to Excellence Center at 6:00 PM on May 2nd. The meeting is open to the public.

According to Golfweek, the 4-Man Scramble is a format frequently played at large-scale events, like fundraisers, where players’ abilities vary widely. 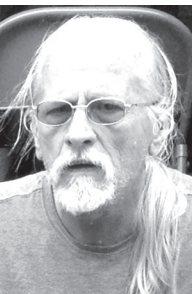

# Be Kind raises money for local non-profits with soup fundraiser over Lent

In order to raise money for Be Kind, every Tuesday throughout the course of Lent Minden Presbyterian Church sold soups to the community, raising \$1200 over the course of a month. The idea to sell soups as a fundraiser came from the event’s organizer, Lauren Phillips. It was a fundraiser that her previous church took part in, and she thought it would work here in Minden as well. “My old church in Magnolia did something similar, but did it with other churches — which is a goal that we have — to get some more community involvement,” said Phillips. This was a new initiative for Be Kind this year. The organization wanted to see how the idea worked in practice on a smaller scale and are looking to partner with other local churches in the future in order to help expand the reach of the program. Selling soups also adheres to the common practices

of Lent itself, staying in theme with the holiday. “One of the ideas of Lent is that you do without some things and that’s why soups are common. So we’ve been selling the soups to raise money for Be Kind, which will be donated to help five local charities,” said the pastor of Minden Presbyterian Church, Keith Mariott. This year Minden Presbyterian decided to keep the fundraiser relatively small-scale to see how effective it was and, given its success, plans to reach out to other churches for help with the initiative in the future. “This year we wanted to do it ourselves to see what the logistics were. Next year we’ll start asking other churches to be involved,” said Mariott. Pastor Mariott was adamant of the fact that, while the Be Kind organization is starting at Minden Presbyterian, all people, regardless of denomination, are welcome to take part in and contribute to the organization. Ultimately, the goal of Be Kind is to have the funds and resources to

be able to contribute to a wide array of the local community’s needs. Be Kind was born in Kentucky by a friend of Mariotts and has been going strong for twelve years now. They have used the organization to help their local community in a variety of ways and serve as an inspiration for what Be Kind here in Minden can accomplish. “The concept of Be Kind came from a friend of mine who’s in KY, and they’ve been doing it for 12 years now, so everyone in their community knows about it. At Christmas last year, they paid all the bus fare from Owensboro for a month. So the buses were free for anyone who wanted to ride. One year they paid for all the school meals, so for the parents who didn’t have money, they took care of it,” said Mariott. Although the ways that Be Kind in Kentucky went about serving the needs of their community were non-conventional compared to more common non-profit organizations, the impact they made was still immense. The good

work that Be Kind does brings more awareness to the organization which, in turn, leads to more people wanting to contribute, creating a positive feedback loop that serves as a force for good in the communities they’re involved in. Since starting up in Minden nearly three years ago, Be Kind has contributed in a variety of ways to the local community such as taking donations and selling signs and then giving the proceeds to local nonprofits as well as helping feed the community in the early phases of the COVID pandemic. Their ultimate goal is to get more local churches and individuals involved in helping the organization to grow while spreading kindness here in the City of Minden. “Minden is a giving town. It is, and Be Kind offers ways to help for the people who want to help. As Be Kind moves forward, I’m eager to see how it will grow and evolve over time,” said Mariott.

Hunter Biden laptop scandal fuels mistrust of national media

Many of us already knew the truth regarding the damaging and scandalous details of the Hunter Biden laptop story. We knew it during the 2020 presidential election. Rather, Big Media is the mouthpiece of the Democrat Party and the national Left, and that is why they are not trusted. According to Gallup, for example, TV news is the second least trusted institution in America, at 18 percent, barely edging Congress. This media dishonesty matters because tight races in three key swing states had a big electoral impact as "just 44,000 votes in Georgia, Arizona and Wisconsin separated Biden and Trump from a tie in the Electoral College." If Biden and Trump had tied 269 to 269 in the Electoral College, the Constitution provides that the President be chosen in the House of Representatives

with each state having one vote for president, with a candidate needing 26 states to win and the winner decided very likely by which party had a majority in each state's delegation. At the time, the Republicans had majorities in 26 state delegations with the Democrats in control of 23 and Pennsylvania with a delegation split between Rs and Ds. So, with 16% of Biden voters changing their mind had they known about the laptop scandal, and only 44 thousand votes in three states being the difference between a tie in the Electoral College, and the majority of U.S. House (Republican) state delegations voting for Trump to break the tie, in quashing the laptop story the media may have changed the election result and, therefore, American and world history. Whatever anyone thinks of Trump and his mean tweets, outlandish statements and over-the-top personality, he left the country in far better shape than the countless economic, foreign policy, and cultural disasters that Joe Biden has caused in barely over a year. This, again, is why millions of Americans don't trust these institutions.

WSJ: Former President Obama has his own history with Russia

Russia's bloody invasion of Ukraine has sparked an Olympic sprint of sorts as politicians run away from their abysmal records regarding Vladimir Putin. Few are running faster than former President Barack Obama, who this week tried to rewrite the history of his own Russia policies. "As somebody who grappled with the incursion into Crimea and the eastern portions of Ukraine, I have been encouraged by the European reaction (this time)," Mr. Obama said at an event in Chicago. "Because in 2014, I often had to drag them kicking and screaming to respond in ways that we would have wanted to see from those of us who describe ourselves as Western democracies." As for Mr. Putin, the former U.S. President purports to be surprised by the Russian leader's brutality. "I don't know that the person I knew is the same as the person who is now leading this charge. He was always ruthless. You witnessed what he did in Chechnya, he had no qualms about crushing those whom he considered a threat. That's not new. For him to bet the farm in this way—I would not

have necessarily predicted from him five years ago." Mr. Obama managed to say all this with a straight face while speaking at an event about "disinformation" in politics. Start with Mr. Obama's claim he was a champion of harsher measures against Russia after the invasion of Crimea and eastern Ukraine in 2014. His Administration imposed only mild, targeted sanctions on Russia—and then joined with Moscow to negotiate a nuclear deal with Iran. He refused to sell Javelin antitank weapons to Ukraine. Germany pushed ahead with its Nord Stream 2 gas pipeline in this era with nary a peep from Washington until the Trump Administration. Mr. Obama also can't claim as much ignorance as he does now about Mr. Putin's intentions and methods at the time. Mr. Putin had risen to power allegedly by bombing apartment buildings in Russia, as U.S. intelligence no doubt knew or highly suspected, and even Mr. Obama concedes Mr. Putin's 1999 assault on Grozny in Chechnya was "ruthless." There also were the 2006 assassinations of journalist Anna Politkovskaya

and Putin critic Alexander Litvinenko, Mr. Putin's provocative speech criticizing the North Atlantic Treaty Organization in Munich in 2007, and the 2008 Russian invasion of Georgia. In 2009 Mr. Obama nonetheless dispatched Secretary of State Hillary Clinton to Geneva to negotiate a "reset" on relations with her Russian counterpart Sergei Lavrov. In 2012 Mr. Obama accused Republican presidential candidate Mitt Romney of hewing to a retrograde 1980s foreign policy for viewing Russia as a threat, while telling Putin henchman Dmitry Medvedev when he thought no one was listening that he'd have more latitude to cut Mr. Putin some slack after the U.S. election. Some reset. In addition to the Crimea and Donbas invasions, 2014 saw the shoot-down of a Malaysian Airlines flight by Russia-linked forces in eastern Ukraine. Russia's cluster bombing of Aleppo in Syria followed in 2015-16. Mr. Putin's suppression of domestic dissent accelerated, and he amped up his rhetoric against NATO and an independent Ukraine. And don't forget the med-

dling in the 2016 U.S. election, which Mr. Obama punished with wrist-slap sanctions only after Donald Trump won. Mr. Obama's main concession to Russian reality was to lobby NATO allies to increase their annual defense spending to 2% of GDP, although for the most part they ignored him. One can almost understand why they did, since they saw him cozying up to Mr. Putin on Iran while talking down the Russia threat. All of this is relevant now because the Biden Administration is loaded with men and women who worked for Mr. Obama and shared his misjudgments about Russia. The conceit in many quarters on the left is that Mr. Putin has changed, or is deranged, such that his Ukraine invasion couldn't have been foreseen. But Mr. Obama's weakness toward Russia, reinforced by former German Chancellor Angela Merkel, is one reason Mr. Putin felt he could act with increasing aggressiveness and get away with it. No one should believe Mr. Obama's varnished Russia history.

Bulldogs implementing new systems under Cumbie

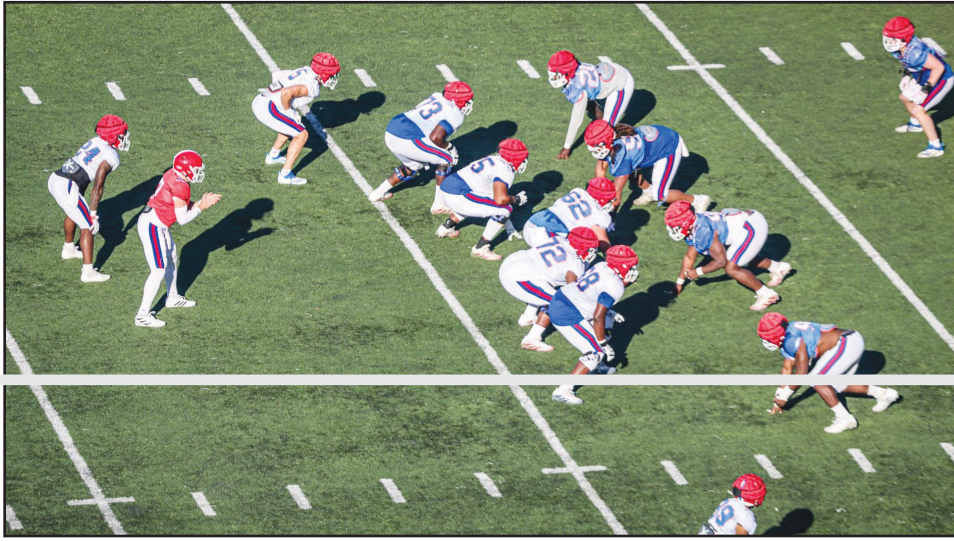

Pelicans down Spurs to stay alive in NBA postseason

NEW ORLEANS (AP) — CJ McCollum got New Orleans going early and Brandon Ingram took over late to send the Pelicans to Los Angeles for a chance at the final playoff spot.

McCollum scored 27 of his 32 points in the first half to carry the young Pelicans to a 113-103 win over the San Antonio Spurs on Wednesday night. New Orleans will face the LA Clippers tonight for the eighth playoff seed.

“He was great,” Pelicans coach Willie Green said of McCollum. “He set the tone early. He understood the moment, and it sort of calmed the rest of the guys down. We just got the ball to him and he made play after play, score after score, and then the rest of the guys that just started to feed off CJ.”

Playing in his 57th playoff game, McCollum displayed a calming presence to his younger teammates. Rookies Herb Jones, José Alvarado and Trey Murphy played large chunks of the fourth quarter.

“I was just trying to be locked in and aggressive early,” McCollum said. “The playoffs are a lot of antics, a lot of momentum plays, a lot of back and forth. You’ve got to be stable and mentally locked in to withstand a certain level of (chaos). ... There’s going to be a lot of winning in our future.”

McCollum wasn’t alone. Ingram shook off foul trouble to add 27 points and center Jonas Valanciunas added 22 points and 14 rebounds as the Pelicans’ stars delivered under pressure of New Orleans’ first postseason game since 2018.

“The three best players for New Orleans all played great, and if that happens, you’re going to lose,” Spurs coach Gregg Popovich said of his team’s inability to contain McCollum, Ingram and Valanciunas. “
